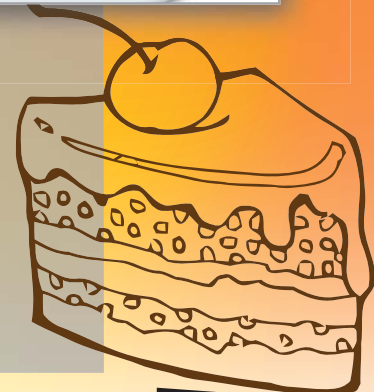


GENERAL RULES



1. The decision of the Chairman of Judges is final.
2. This competition is open to all cake decorators except employees of International Centre of Cake Artistry Sdn Bhd (ICCA), the organizing committee, and their families. All commissioned contributors to Squires Kitchen MP Magazines and any tutors or demonstrators at Squires Kitchen School are also restricted from entering the competition.
3. Exhibits entered individually must be the bona fide unaided work of a single competitor, including any child entering the children's classes.
4. A competitor may submit a maximum of two entries per category.
5. Competitors cannot enter pieces from previous competitions.
6. Competitors must comply with the specification of each class or their entry will not be judged.
7. Boards can be of any shape but must fit inside a square of the dimensions shown for each class. The imperial dimensions quoted are rounded to the nearest inch. Where no height restriction is specified, competitors must be aware that all entries are restricted by the size of the Competition Area and discretion should be used.
8. Dummies may be used unless otherwise specified.
9. Where 'no artificial or commercial decoration allowed' is stated in the schedule, (with the exception of decorative ribbon around the edge of the board) nothing inedible or commercially produced may be used in that class. Please ensure especially with metallic and glitter colours that you clarify with the manufacturer that the items used are EDIBLE.
10. Entrants should be aware that, where 'a minimum amount of...' is stated in the schedule, this enables you to use any, or all, of the items specified, but with discretion.
11. Where ribbon insertion is used on an entry, only edible (sugar) ribbon insertion is allowed.
12. Only supports for tiered cakes, plastic pillars which are inserted into cakes, flower picks (or equivalent) may be inserted into competition entries. Wires and other non food-grade items must NOT be inserted directly into the sugar/edible medium
13. Where used, the top open edge of flower picks must be visible.
14. All entry forms with full payments MUST be submitted by 15th August 2010 to Lyphine Gan (ICCA). NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE. PAYMENTS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.
15. Entrants will be given a set of rules for their chosen class(es) once their entry form has been processed. Please read these rules carefully as any entry not complying with the rules of the class will be disqualified.
16. ICCA reserves the right to refuse entries not abiding by the rules.
17. Competition is open to individuals only.
